The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the following Walk Bridge Program activities for Saturday, July 15, 2017 through Saturday, July 22, 2017

IN-WATER ACTIVITY

- In-water subsurface investigation work is anticipated to occur north of the Walk Bridge to the west of the navigation channel, Saturday, July 15, 2017 and Monday, July 17 through Saturday, July 22, 2017 from 6:00 AM-6:00 PM. No impacts to local river users, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)

RAILROAD/LOCAL PROGRAM ACTIVITY

- Subsurface investigation work is anticipated to occur adjacent to the Walk Bridge west approach railroad tracks, Monday, July 17 through Wednesday, July 19, 2017 from 8:00 PM-4:00 AM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
- Subsurface investigation work is anticipated to occur adjacent to the Walk Bridge east approach railroad tracks, Wednesday, July 19 through Friday, July 21, 2017 from 8:00 AM-4:00 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
- A nighttime lane closure will occur on East Avenue for subsurface investigation work in the vicinity of the railroad bridge on Thursday, July 20, 2017 from 8:00 PM-4:00 AM. One-lane of alternating traffic will be maintained and access will be maintained to all properties. [Map](#)

One of the oldest movable bridges in the country, the Walk Bridge is a critical transportation link on the Northeast Corridor between Washington, D.C., New York City and Boston carrying four tracks of Metro-North Railroad, Amtrak and freight service.
