



# Walk Bridge Program CONSTRUCTION NEWS

Effective Friday, April 13, 2018

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the following Walk Bridge Program activities for Friday, April 13, 2018 through Monday, April 23, 2018.

## RAILROAD ACTIVITY

- Track work is anticipated to occur on the Danbury Line between the mainline wye and Jennings Place, Monday, April 16 through Friday, April 20, 2018 from 6:30 AM-3:30 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. Please watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles. - Bridge plates are anticipated to be installed on the northbound track at East Norwalk, Westport and Green's Farms railroad stations at night, Saturday, April 14 through the morning of Sunday, April 15, 2018 from 10:00 PM-6:00 AM. - Track work is anticipated to occur on the Danbury Line in the vicinity of the Ann Street Railroad Bridge at night, Friday, April 20 through the morning of Saturday, April 21, 2018 from 10:00 PM-6:00 AM. Intermittent noise and construction illumination are anticipated as a result of this work. Please note, construction vehicles will be traveling on the Danbury Line between Science Road and Ann Street. [Map](#)
- Track work is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of Norden Place at night, Monday, April 16 through the morning of Saturday, April 21, 2018 from 10:00 PM-6:00 AM. Intermittent noise and construction illumination are anticipated as a result of this work. ## ROADWAY ACTIVITY

- Selective tree clearing and grubbing is anticipated to occur on the south side of the railroad tracks on the New Haven Line, east of Howard Avenue in the vicinity of Heron Court, Monday, April 16 through Friday, April 20, 2018 from 8:00 AM-3:30 PM.
