## Railroad Activity

**Track work on the Danbury Line between [Washington Street and Jennings Place](#)**

- Monday, August 13 - Sunday, August 19 from 6:30 AM - 5:00 PM
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles
- Noise is anticipated

**Track work near Norden Place, on the south side of the New Haven Line, between [Howard Avenue and Bridge Street](#)**

- Monday, August 13 - Friday, August 17 from 6:30 AM - 5:00 PM
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated

## Local Road Activity

**Ann Street is [closed to thru traffic](#) to facilitate the first half of the Ann Street Railroad Bridge superstructure replacement.**

- Road closed until August 27
- Ann Street property access will be maintained
- Pedestrians are encouraged to use Marshall Street
- Ann Street will be open to thru traffic the nights of August 7 and 14 to accommodate the SoNo Collection Mall's N. Water Street closure

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The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) is undertaking the Walk Bridge Program to replace the deteriorating railroad bridge over the Norwalk River in Norwalk, CT. One of the oldest movable bridges in the country, the Walk Bridge is a critical transportation link on the Northeast Corridor between Washington, D.C., New York City and Boston carrying four tracks of Metro-North Railroad, Amtrak and freight service.
