Railroad Activity

Track work on the [Danbury Line](#) near the Ann Street Railroad Bridge

- Friday, September 14 - Friday, September 21 from 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM
- No impacts to local roads or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles
- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated

[Science Road](#) Railroad Crossing Replacement

- Friday, September 14 at 4:00 PM continuously through 5:00 AM the morning of Monday, September 17
- [Danbury Branch service](#) will be bused at night Friday, September 14 - 5:00 AM the morning of Monday, September 17.
- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated
- The City of Norwalk's Transfer Station will be closed on Saturday, September 15 to accommodate this work
- Norwalk River Valley Trail entrance at the Science Road railroad crossing will be closed. The trail will remain open to the north and south connection. Pedestrians are encouraged to access the trail from the N. Water Street entrance for Oyster Shell Park.

Nighttime subsurface investigation work to the [west of the Walk Bridge](#)

- Monday, September 17 - Tuesday, September 18 from 10:00 PM - 4:00 AM
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are expected
- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated

Local Road Activity

Daytime lane closure on [Ann Street](#) to facilitate the Railroad Bridge superstructure replacement

- Friday, September 14 - Friday, September 21 from 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM
- One lane of alternating one-way traffic will be maintained
- North side of the sidewalk will be opened to pedestrians

Subsurface investigation work in the [Iron Works Building alleyway](#)

- Monday, September 17 - Wednesday, September 19 from 9:00 AM - 4:30 PM
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Noise is expected as a result of this construction activity

Subsurface investigation work in the [Lock Building parking lot](#)

- Saturday, September 22 - Sunday, September 23 from 6:00 AM - 6:00 PM
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Noise is expected as a result of this construction activity

Drainage work on [Goldstein Place](#)

- Monday, September 17 - Sunday, September 23 from 6:30 AM - 3:30 PM
- One lane of alternating one-way traffic will be maintained
- Local business, resident and pedestrian access will be maintained

Additional Activity

Rock grinding on the south side of the New Haven Line, between [Howard Avenue and Bridge Street](#)

- Work is expected during daytime and nighttime hours, Wednesdays - Sundays for the foreseeable future
- Wednesday mornings - Friday mornings from 6:30 AM - 3:30 PM and 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM
- Friday nights - Sunday nights from 10:00 PM - 10:00 AM and 10:00 AM - 10:00 PM
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated

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The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) is undertaking the Walk Bridge Program to replace the deteriorating railroad bridge over the Norwalk River in Norwalk, CT. One of the oldest movable bridges in the country, the Walk Bridge is a critical transportation link on the Northeast Corridor between Washington, D.C., New York City and Boston carrying four tracks of Metro-North Railroad, Amtrak and freight service.
