## Railroad Activity

### **Track work on the [Danbury Branch](#) between Marshall Street and Jennings Place**

- Monday, November 5 - Friday, November 9 from 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM
- No impacts to local roads or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles
- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated

### **Nighttime track work on the [Danbury Branch](#) between Marshall Street and Jennings Place**

- Thursday, November 8 from 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated

### **Mobilization of a work area near the railroad tracks between [N. Main Street and N. Water Street](#)**

- Monday, November 5 - Friday, November 9 from 6:30 AM - 4:00 PM
- Parking spaces located closest to the railroad will be impacted
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated

## Local Road Activity

### **Daytime lane closure on [Ann Street](#) to facilitate Ann Street Railroad Bridge construction**

- Monday, November 5 - Friday, November 9 from 7:00 AM - 4:30 PM
- Alternating one-way traffic will be maintained
- Ann Street property access will be maintained
- Pedestrians are encouraged to use Marshall Street
- Noise is anticipated

### **Nighttime lane closure on [South Smith Street](#) to facilitate subsurface utility work**

- Monday, November 5 - Friday, November 9 from 4:00 PM - 5:00 AM
- Alternating one-way traffic will be maintained
- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated
- Property access will be maintained
- No impacts to rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated

### **Daytime lane closure on [Water Street](#) to facilitate driving and removal of piles**

- Tuesday, November 6 from 7:30 AM - 4:00 PM
- Lane closure is anticipated for only a few hours
- Alternate route via Haviland Street is available in the event of a brief road closure

## In River Activity

### Intermittent driving and removal of piles in the [Norwalk River](#)

- Starting Tuesday, November 6 from 7:30 AM - 4:00 PM
- Noise and vibration anticipated
- Pile-driving is not anticipated during lunch and dinner hours while in close proximity to local restaurants
- One channel will remain open for navigation at all times
- River users are asked to use caution around the construction. There is signage posted on the river and marine police presence to guide river users.

## Additional Activity

### Rock grinding on the south side of the New Haven Line, between [Howard Avenue and Bridge Street](#)

- Friday, November 2 - Sunday, November 4 from 6:30 AM - 3:30 PM and Wednesday, November 7 - Sunday, November 11, 2018
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Noise is anticipated
