The Danbury Branch Dockyard Project consists of electrifying the Danbury Branch between Washington Street and Jennings Place in Norwalk, CT. This enables trains ending their service in South Norwalk to switch direction for the return trip to Grand Central Terminal. Additional rail improvements included in this project are:

- Two new tracks between Marshall Street and Science Road
- Track replacement and realignment
- New catenary structures
- New communications and signal system upgrades
- Ann Street Railroad Bridge superstructure replacement

Construction Progress (August 2018)

- Overhead wires removed
- Tracks 2, 4 & 6 removed
- Sub-ballast & ballast excavation & replacement
- Tree-trimming/clearing along the Danbury Branch
- New catenary foundations (East and West)

Upcoming Construction Activities

- New catenary structures
- Additional ballast installation
- New track installation (2, 4 & 6)
- Railroad drainage installation

Work will occur during daytime hours when possible, with night and weekend hours as necessary

Ann Street Railroad Bridge

As part of the Danbury Branch Dockyard Project, the superstructure of the rail bridge over Ann Street will be replaced with a new weathering steel deck and beams. Abutment wall improvements will include resetting the existing stone and new stained concrete caps. The proposed bridge will maintain the 19th century character of the existing bridge.
