Railroad Activity

Track work on the [Danbury Branch](#) between Marshall Street and Jennings Place

- Monday, February 11 - Friday, February 15 from 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM
- No impacts to local roads or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles
- Noise is anticipated

Drilled shafts and signal house construction on the New Haven Line between [N. Main Street and N. Water Street](#)

- Friday, February 8 - Sunday, February 17 from 6:30 AM - 3:30 PM
- Expect additional noise as a result of drilled shaft work
- Night work may take place the weekends of Friday, February 8 - Sunday, February 10 and Friday, February 15 - Sunday, February 17 from 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM pending Metro-North Railroad operations
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated

Local Road Activity

- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated

- Tuesday, February 12 - Thursday, February 14 from 11:00 PM - 7:00 AM
- Friday, February 15 - Saturday, February 16 from 12:00 AM - 5:00 PM
- Sunday, February 17 from 12:00 AM - 8:00 AM
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
