## Railroad Activity

### Track work on the [Danbury Branch](#) between Marshall Street and Jennings Place

- Monday, February 18 - Friday, February 22 from 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM
- No impacts to local roads or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles
- Noise is anticipated

### Drilled shafts and signal house construction on the New Haven Line between [N. Main Street and N. Water Street](#)

- Friday, February 15 - Sunday, February 24 from 6:30 AM - 3:30 PM
- Expect additional noise as a result of drilled shaft work
- Night work may take place the weekends of Friday, February 15 - Sunday, February 17 and Friday, February 22 - Sunday, February 24 from 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM pending Metro-North Railroad operations
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated

## Local Road Activity

### Sidewalk closure due to subsurface investigations on [N. Water Street](#)

- Friday, February 15, Monday, February 18 and Friday, February 22 from 7:00 AM - 4:30 PM
- No impacts to local roads or rail service are anticipated
- Sidewalk opposite this work remains open for pedestrians
- Noise is anticipated

### Daytime lane closure due to subsurface investigations on [N. Water Street](#)

- Tuesday, February 19 - Thursday, February 21 from 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM
- Alternating one-way traffic is maintained
- Local pedestrian, business, residential, driveway and parking lot access is maintained
- No impacts to rail service are anticipated
- Noise is anticipated

### Daytime lane closure due to construction of the Ann Street Railroad Bridge on [Ann Street](#)

- Tuesday, February 19 - Thursday, February 21 from 9:00 AM - 4:30 PM
- Alternating one-way traffic is maintained
- No impacts to rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Noise is anticipated

### Road closure due to construction of the Ann Street Railroad Bridge on [Ann Street](#)

- Friday, February 22 from 3:00 PM - 10:00 PM
- Saturday, February 23 from 9:00 AM - 6:00 PM
- No impacts to rail service are anticipated
- Pedestrians are encouraged to use Marshall Street
- Noise is anticipated

### Day and night rock excavation on the south side of the New Haven Line, between [Howard Avenue and Bridge Street](#)

- Continuous work starting Friday at 6:30 AM through Monday at 6:00 AM over the next two weekends (February 15 - 18 and February 22 - 25)
- Day and night work is anticipated Monday, February 18 - Friday, February 22 from 6:30 AM - 3:30 PM and 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated

### Day and night slope stabilization between [Triangle Street and Bridge Street](#)

- Tuesday, February 19 - Thursday, February 21 from 11:00 PM - 7:00 AM
- Friday, February 22 - Saturday, February 23 from 12:00 AM - 5:00 PM
- Sunday, February 24 from 12:00 AM - 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM - 4:00 AM Monday morning
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated. Expect additional noise as a result of this activity.
