## Railroad Activity

### Track work on the [Danbury Branch](#) between Marshall Street and Jennings Place

- Monday, June 10 - Friday, June 14 from 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM.
- Night work on Friday, June 14 from 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM.
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated.
- Watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles.
- Noise is anticipated.

### Signal house construction on the [New Haven Line](#) between N. Water Street and N. Main Street

- Day work: Saturday, June 8 and Sunday, June 9 from 6:00 AM - 6:00 PM. Monday, June 10 - Monday, June 14 from 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM.
- Night work: Monday, June 10 - Friday, June 14 from 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM.
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated.
- Noise is anticipated.

### Track work on the [New Haven Line](#) near Howard Avenue

- Friday, June 7 - Sunday, June 16 from 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM and 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM.
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated.
- Noise and construction lighting are anticipated. Expect additional noise as a result of this activity.

## Local Road Activity

### Closures on [Ann Street](#) for construction of the railroad bridge

- Full closure: Monday, June 10 and Tuesday, June 11 from 6:30 AM - 4:00 PM.
- Detours are set up to redirect traffic.
- Alternating one-way traffic: Wednesday, June 12 - Friday, June 14, 6:30AM - 4:30PM.
- Access to the Corset Factory's back parking lot from Ann Street will be closed during this activity. Tenants will be able to access the parking lot from Pine Street. Access to the front parking lot will remain open.
- Pedestrians are encouraged to use Marshall Street.
- No impacts to rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated.
- Noise is anticipated.

### Lane closure on [N. Water Street](#) for sewer inspections

- Thursday, June 13 and Friday, June 14 from 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM.
- Alternating one-way traffic is maintained.
- No impacts to rail service anticipated.
- Noise is anticipated.

- Work is weather permitting and is rescheduled as necessary.

  - Intermittent lane closures are anticipated as necessary.

  - Nightly Monday, June 10 - Friday, June 14 from 8:00 PM - 5:00 AM.
