



Walk Bridge Program CONSTRUCTION NEWS

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the following Walk Bridge Program activities for Saturday, June 16, 2017 through Saturday, June 24, 2017.

IN-WATER ACTIVITY

- In-water subsurface investigation work is anticipated to occur just south of the Walk Bridge, west of the navigation channel, Saturday, June 17, 2017 and Monday, June 19 through Friday, June 23, 2017 from 6:00 AM-6:00 PM. No impacts to local river users, rail services or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)

RAILROAD/LOCAL ROAD ACTIVITY

- Subsurface investigation work is anticipated to occur on the railroad tracks immediately west of the Walk Bridge, Monday, June 19 through Thursday, June 22, 2017 from 8:00 PM-6:00 AM. Rail services will be maintained and no impacts to local roads or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
- Subsurface surveying work is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of the Danbury Branch Dockyard and Science Road, Tuesday, June 20 and Wednesday, June 21, 2017 from 8:00 AM-4:00 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail services or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
- Walk Bridge openings are anticipated to occur on Sunday, June 18, 2017 from 9:00 AM-4:00 PM. Rail services will be maintained and no impacts to local river users or pedestrian traffic are anticipated.

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The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) is undertaking the Walk Bridge Program to replace the deteriorating railroad bridge over the Norwalk River in Norwalk, CT. One of the oldest movable bridges in the country, the Walk Bridge is a critical transportation link on the Northeast Corridor between Washington, D.C., New York City and Boston carrying four tracks of Metro-North Railroad, Amtrak and freight service.
