

## **Walk Bridge Program UPDATE**

## **Permits**

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) has been informed by the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) that the Public Notice period for Permit. No. 201909990-TWSDF began on November 15, 2021. The Department looks forward to receiving the approved permits for this critical transportation infrastructure project with construction on the Walk Bridge replacement project expected to begin in Spring 2022.



## Tracking Progress on the Walk Bridge Program

Progress continues for various components on the Walk Bridge Program. Two active construction projects, the CP243 Interlocking and Danbury Dockyard, will be completed in 2022. The Dockyard Project includes the electrification of the lower Danbury Branch, allowing for Metro-North trains to turn at Norwalk without increasing congestion on the mainline of the Northeast Corridor during the Walk Bridge replacement. The new CP243 four-track Interlocking system on the New Haven line is anticipated to be in operation in early 2023. The new Interlocking system lessens the impact of the two -track rail operations needed to replace the existing Walk Bridge.

Other projects affiliated with the Walk Bridge Program include the current Advance Utility Project (AUP) on East Avenue, and the replacement of three railroad bridges over Fort Point Street, Osborne Avenue and East Avenue in East Norwalk. Infrastructure improvement projects on the East Avenue roadway and the East Norwalk Train Station round out the Program.
